
### This months learning focus is:-

Christmas - We will be taking part in a range of different activities for Christmas such as



making Christmas paper chains, making a snowman, making snowflakes, singing Christmas songs, Christmas junk modelling, making Santa's hat and many more. We will be talking about how we celebrate Christmas and what we do on Christmas day with our family.

Looking for shapes and patterns – The children will be given different patterns to explore with and to also try to make the different patterns. We will also look at 2D shapes and 3D shapes and we will identify the different shapes in our environment. Children will take part in activities such as a shape hunt, drawing shapes, recognising shapes, finding shapes in our messy tray, finding shapes in sand/water and many more.



We're going on a bear hunt - The children are looking at the story, we're going on a bear hunt



with the practitioners. The children will be reading the story, using the story sack with puppets and props to familiarise themselves with the story and interact with the story with the different characters.

We will also create our own bear hunt in the garden to act out the story.

#### Peapods values and dispositions:


# NO PULL UPS
